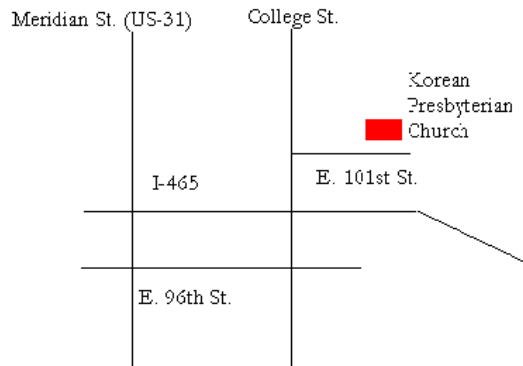

WHEN & WHERE: The day camp will be held on **Saturday, September 10** at The Korean Presbyterian Church of Indianapolis. **Registration begins at 9:00 AM with the formal program beginning at 9:30 AM.** The Korean Presbyterian Church is located at **1020 E. 101st Street in Indianapolis.** Take I-465 to Meridian Street (Hwy 31), go south to E. 96th St. Turn left onto 96th Street and then turn left onto College. Head north to 101st St. Turn right onto 101st St. and proceed to 1020 E. 101st St.
